
What part of the organizational community do you feel you connect with the most?

The voices and information from local communities needs to be the foundation of a sustained and integrated Arctic Observing System.

sustained funding, better collaboration, building on existing networks, dedicated technology development

Funding is always primary. :) And also greater information sharing and coordination across a diverse, fragmented "ecosystem" of activities. Perhaps most important on this front is to have diverse systems measure the same parameters (ie., essential variables) in compatible ways such that data fusion would be possible.

IARPC Collaborations has been a huge help at the US level. The work of SAON could be strengthened, but is moving in the right direction (for example with US AON and AOS being more active in coordination with SAON). There will be lessons learned coming out of MOSAIC, particularly with regard to data fusion products, that are worth looking at carefully. Better collaboration across systems often depends on the passion and motivation of individuals that step up, but there are ways to support that and also bring organizations together.
